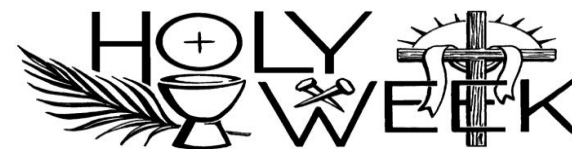

Beto), the pastor at Sacred Heart Church in Durango, will be the spiritual director for the pilgrimage to France July 28-August 7, 2026. Highlights of the pilgrimage will be Paris, Sacre' Coeur, Notre Dame Cathedral and the Chapel where our Blessed Mother manifested the Miraculous Medal to St. Catherine Laboure in 1830, Lisieux, home of the Little Flower, Saint Thérèse, Omaha Beach, Paray-le-Monial (the site of the revelations of the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque), Mont St Michel, and Lourdes, where the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette. **Cost** for double occupancy at 4- star hotels with breakfast and dinner, coach bus transportation, and a RT flight from Denver to Paris is \$5800.
