**Sunday at 3:00 p.m.**

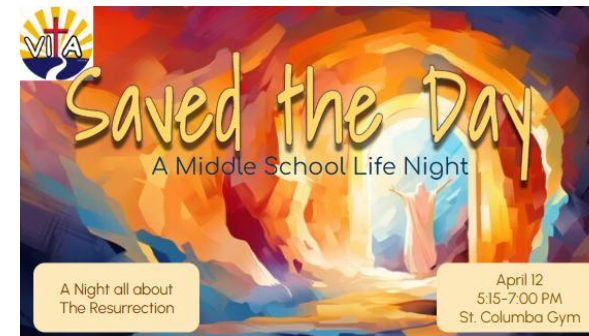

This feast was established following the visions of St. Faustina Kowalska, who recorded in her diary that Jesus requested a special feast dedicated to His Divine Mercy to be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter.

The celebration emphasizes God's Infinite Mercy, encouraging the faithful to seek forgiveness, receive Holy Communion and participate in prayers and devotions dedicated to Divine Mercy.

The Church teaches that those who participate faithfully in these practices may receive plenary indulgences, meaning the complete remission of temporal punishment for sins.
