Bishop Berg is asking that the **special collection for the weekend of May 16- 17 be used to build a fund for aiding struggling parishes in the diocese**, especially those with mission churches. In many of these communities, there are little to no resources available for important repairs and other special needs. For example, the mission churches of the San Luis Valley have a very rich historical heritage, and struggle with basic maintenance to be viable and safe for worship. There are other Rural Parishes and Missions throughout the diocese with similar needs.
