The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) is the Catholic Church’s formal process for adults to become fully initiated members through Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist, involving prayer, study, and community life. The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults is for 1) adults who have never been baptized who seek to become Catholic. 2) It is also for adults who were baptized in another Christian church who seek to become Catholic and 3) adults who were already baptized as Catholic, but who have not celebrated the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Communion, or Confirmation. 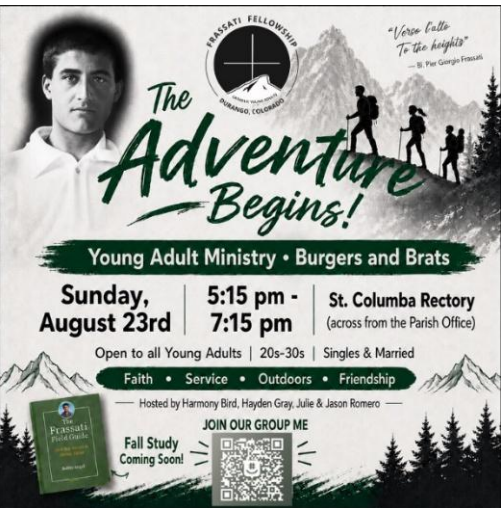
Reading the Icon of San Damiano
